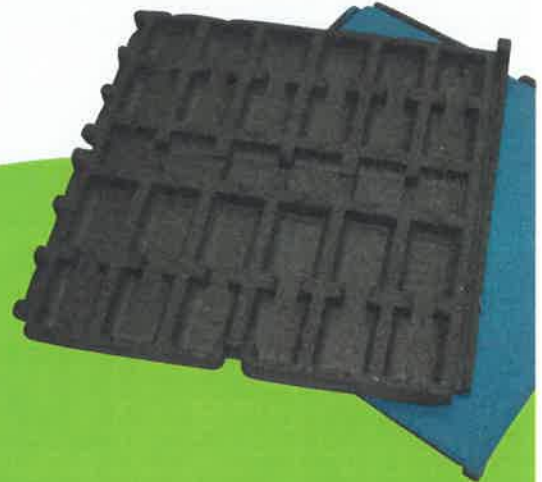

This would generate approximately 36,900 lbs. of feed stock per month for product fabrication; the equivalent of removing about 3,600 tires from the waste stream monthly.
