Please submit an electronically signed, one-page EDS Certificate of Filing, which validates that the EDS has been filed. Additionally, the Municipal Code of Chicago requires the disclosure of Familial Relationships with Elected City Officials and Department Heads. 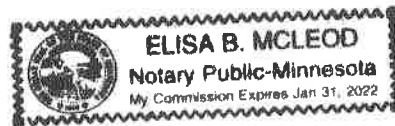
