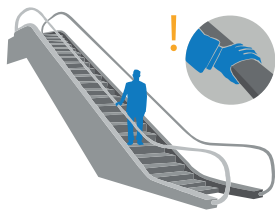

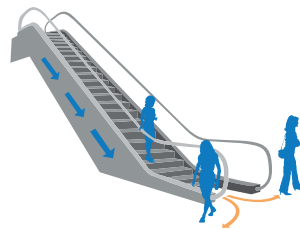

Escalators Do's



Always hold the escalator handrail. If an event of a sudden stop, holding the handrail could prevent a fall.



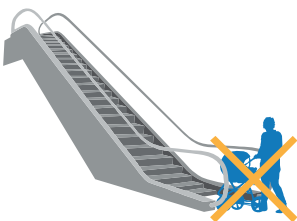
Move away from the exit area of the escalator to allow others a safe means to exit the escalator.



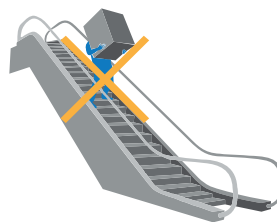
Keep your feet clear of the sides of the escalator to help side skirt entrapments.



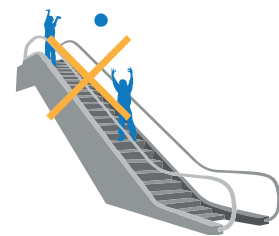
Escalators Don'ts



Never take strollers, wheel chairs or walkers on an escalator. Look for the nearest elevator to access your desired floor.



Do not transport large objects, such as oversized boxes or suitcases on an escalator. Always transport large objects in elevators.



Never horseplay on or around escalators. Always face forward and hold the handrail when riding.
