Project Overview & Needs

Grace Community is a multi-site church and K-12 School in Tyler, Texas, two hours west of Dallas. The growing church has multiple ministries and were quickly outgrowing their office spaces.

The church decided to build a new space for their offices, yet the budget was tight. They assumed the only option for office furniture was to buy used. The local dealer salesperson was a member of Grace Community and suggested the OMNIA Partners Public Sector contract, which is specifically tailored for nonprofits. Church officials began meeting with the dealer and AIS rep on a weekly basis to discuss and refine the layout, create supportive product applications and to choose fabrics and finishes. The result was a cohesive, flexible space.

The Results

Grace Community prides itself on the teams that make both church and school successful. The AIS dealer and rep understood this and offered solutions to support teamwork.

The open offices are either shared or have low profile panels to encourage discussion between employees. Meeting spaces are flexible. Day-to-Day tables were chosen with mobile options so spaces could easily change to meet the needs of various teams who use the space daily. Flip-top tables, along with Stow seating, could nest together when not in use, giving space multiuse capabilities.

In the end, Grace Community received more than they anticipated - new, functional furniture that met their specific needs at a price that fell within their budget thanks to the OMNIA Partners contract.
