The Board of Directors of Region 4 Education Service Center (ESC) issued RFP 21-08 on April 7, 2021, to establish a Texas cooperative contract for Internet Service Provider for TEA Texas Connect Program.

The solicitation included cooperative purchasing language in Section I. Scope of Work:

NATIONAL CONTRACT

Region 4 ESC, as the Principal Procurement Agency, defined in Appendix D, has partnered with OMNIA Partners to make the resultant contract (also known as the "Master Agreement" in materials distributed by OMNIA Partners) from this solicitation available to other public agencies nationally, including state and local governmental entities, public and private primary, secondary and higher education entities, non-profit entities, and agencies for the public benefit ("Public Agencies"), through OMNIA Partners' cooperative purchasing program. The Region 4 is acting as the contracting agency for any other Public Agency that elects to utilize the resulting Master Agreement. Use of the Master Agreement by any Public Agency is preceded by their registration with OMNIA Partners (a "Participating Public Agency"). Appendix D contains additional information about OMNIA Partners and the cooperative purchasing agreement.

The proposals were evaluated by an evaluation committee. Using the evaluation criteria established in the RFP, the committee determined that AT&T Corp. demonstrated the ability to provide the services outlined in the solicitation while offering competitive pricing to members.

Region 4 ESC executed agreements with a contract effective date of August 1, 2021.

Contract Highlights:

AT&T High Speed Internet–Enterprise, a broadband internet access service that uses copper and/or fiber facilities. High Speed Internet–Enterprise provides 24/7 internet access at speeds fast enough—up to 1 Gbps.

Contract includes:

Services include Internet service and any necessary equipment to provide wired broadband service to support the TEA Connect Texas program.

Term:

Initial three-year agreement from August 1, 2021 through July 31, 2024 with the option to renew for two (2) additional one-year periods or portions thereof.
