


## SENATE BILL 721

## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

"The Balcony Inspection Bill." The bill arises in response to the tragic deaths of six UC Berkeley students in 2015 at a downtown apartment complex due to the collapse of a balcony. On September 17, 2018, California Governor Jerry Brown signed into law SB 721 in response. Owners of multi-family apartment buildings with three or more units have until January 1, 2025, to complete the first inspection on "Exterior Elevated Elements" (EEE) — balconies, decks, porches, walkways and/or stairways. This law took effect January 1, 2019. A sample of required buildings is pictured in the diagram below.
