Final Notice and Public Expenditure of a Proposed Activity in a Wetland

To: All Interested Agencies, Groups, and Individuals
This is to give notice that SRE Solar Origination 1 LLC under Part 58 has conducted an evaluation as required by Executive Order 11900, to determine the potential effect that its activity in the wetland will have on the human environment for Moxey's Mill Road Solar Energy Project under USDA Rural Development (RDA) under its Rural Energy for America Program (REAP). The proposed project is located at 133 Moxey's Mills Road in Winsdor (Kennebec County), Maine. The Project area consists of a 10.77-acre, 20kW solar array. Impacts to wetlands are 1165 square feet.

SRE Solar Origination 1 LLC has considered the following alternatives and mitigation measures to be taken to minimize adverse impacts and to restore and preserve natural and beneficial values. Site alternative, not chosen due to proximity to existing transmission corridor, avoiding placement of solar arrays on wetlands, not chosen due to reduced number of arrays and permanent effects caused by access roads through wetlands. Any access road that is disturbed from construction will be restored and low growth wetland vegetation allowed to regenerate.

SRE Solar Origination 1 LLC has reviewed the alternatives to building in the wetland and has determined that it has no practicable alternative. Environmental files that document compliance with steps 3 through 6 of Executive Order 11988 and 11990, are available for public inspection, review and copying upon request at the times and location delineated in the last paragraph of this notice for receipt of comments. This activity will have no significant impact on the environment for the following reasons:

The Project has been designed to minimize site impacts to the extent practicable. 13,229 square feet of wetland will be impacted directly for the development of the Project. There is no tree clearing for the Project. The solar array has been designed to avoid and minimize impacts to more sensitive wetland features on site.

There are three primary purposes for this notice. First, people who may be affected by activities in wetlands and those who have an interest in the protection of the natural environment should be given an opportunity to express their concerns and provide information about these areas. Second, an adequate public notice program can be an important public educational tool. The dissemination of information about wetlands can facilitate and enhance Federal efforts to reduce the risks associated with the occupancy and modification of these special areas. Third, as a matter of fairness, when the Federal government determines it will participate in actions taking place in wetlands, it must inform those who may be put at greater or continued risk.

Ericsson wins wild IndyCar race

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – An IndyCar race mired by eight cautions and a red flag through the first 55 laps saw its lone solid showdown end in more red flag carnage Sunday on the streets of Nashville. And as happened with his first NTT IndyCar Series victory on the streets of Detroit in June, Marcus Ericsson endured to take the checkered flag.

After his No. 8 Chip Ganassi Honda went airborne after contact on a lap 4 restart, forcing his crew to replace his front wing and serve a separate stop-and-go penalty for unavoidable contact, Ericsson won a war of attrition in the inaugural Music City Grand Prix.

“It’s unbelievable. It shows in IndyCar, anything can happen if you never give up,” Ericsson said on the postrace broadcast. “If you have a good team and a good car, you can still get it to victory lane.

“I can’t believe it; I just can’t believe it.”

After Dale Coyne Racing’s Cody Ware spun in Turn 3 on lap 55 to bring out the race’s eighth yellow flag, those in attendance and watching the NBC Sports broadcast saw nearly 20 laps of solid racing between Ericsson and pole-sitter Colton Herta, who turned in the fastest laps in both practices and dominated Saturday’s Fast 6 qualifying session.

With 11 laps to go, Herta locked his tires while nearing a possible passing opportunity and barely missed the wall, increasing Ericsson’s cushion from a half-second to more than two seconds.

But Herta, knowing Ericsson was nursing a very narrow window for fuel saving, hunted the Swedish driver back down. He was closing hard on lap 75 after coming back over the Korean War Veterans Memorial Bridge, which provided the field two separate straights the length of the ones at Indianapolis Motor Speedway.

Coming into Turn 9 going 150-plus-mph, Herta said he just “overdid it,” trying to brake late and couldn’t keep his No. 26 Gainbridge Honda out of the tire barrier, causing a yellow flag and an

eventual red. Though the NBC Sports broadcast showed Herta didn’t let go of the steering wheel before impact, he said postrace that his wrists were OK heading into next weekend’s IMS road race.

“Tunnel vision, man. I feel terrible. We had the car all weekend to win, and man, I threw it away,” Herta said. “This place is brutal; I think we saw that.

“Congrats to Marcus, he drove a hell of a race there at the end. I didn’t think he was going to make it and he just kept pulling away from me. I just feel terrible for the team and everyone involved. ... I was just pushing to try and get ahead of him as soon as I can, and I overdid it.”

With Herta out of the race, Ericsson was pursued by teammate Scott Dixon, who finished runner-up, 1.5596 seconds back. James Hinchcliffe nabbed third place for his best NTT IndyCar Series finish since he also took third at Iowa in 2019. The victory for the driver of the No. 8 car gives CGR five wins over 11 races this year and puts Ericsson with teammate and series points leader Alex Palou (who is now 42 points ahead of Dixon, who moved into second) and Pato O’Ward as multiple-race winners in 2021.

Ryan Hunter Reay (4th), Graham Rahal (5th), Ed Jones (6th), Palou (7th), Felix Rosenqvist (8th), Helio Castroneves (9th) and Josef Newgarden (10th) rounded out the top 10.

Music City GP wasn’t a race but a party

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – That was something else, wasn’t it?

The kind of crazy, untamed enjoyment that comes with seeing race cars zip through hairpin turns on the same downtown streets we regularly commute – though, you’d hope, a bit slower.

Look, honey! That crash was where we tailgate for Tennessee Titans games!

Sunday afternoon’s (deep breath) inaugural Big Machine IndyCar Music City Grand Prix (exhale) represented a new treat for our city.

Maybe it wasn’t great racing with all the caution flags during the competition, but for the most part, this weekend was a success.

Because it wasn’t about a race anyway. It was about the spectacle.

“For the first crack at it as an event, this was pretty freaking awesome,” driver James Hinchcliffe said.

“This town knew that we were here, and it looked like it loved that we were here.”

Over three days, more than 100,000 people withstood brutal summer heat. They packed grandstands and stood shoulder to shoulder on ramps in Nissan Stadium, and I’d bet the vast majority didn’t know much about the NTT IndyCar Series drivers they were watching, including Marcus Ericsson from Sweden, the eventual winner.

Nashville loves NASCAR and football and these days maybe even hockey. But outside of a rooting interest in local product Josef Newgarden, Music City isn’t much of an IndyCar hotbed – I mean, is there another in the country besides Indianapolis?

A big party downtown, though? We can do that.

“It can’t just be a race. It has to be an event, OK? And nobody throws a party like Nashville,” said Joe Mattioli, who watched Sunday with his wife while attending a rooftop event at The Joseph Hotel.

Mattioli wasn’t just any racegoer. He’s the former president of Pocono Raceway, and he has a history with Nashville and at the Fairgrounds Speedway Nashville. He understands this city and how to promote an event here.

Remember the DukesFest years ago at the Fairgrounds, celebrating the “Dukes of Hazzard”?

That was Mattioli. He has raced school buses and mascots and even pastors on golf carts with jugs of water on the back. Whoever went faster without spilling the water would earn a church donation.

“The whole idea (of promotion) is to get people there, and generally they’re going to find something they like,” Mattioli said.

“But you’ve got to get them there to begin with.”

That was the inspiration behind this IndyCar race – Mattioli’s idea.

Going back to 2007, Mattioli tried unsuccessfully at least twice to start the race that finally came to life Sunday.

Each attempt was derailed, basically, by bad timing. The Nashville flood in 2010 halted the first try. Efforts were redoubled in 2015, leading to serious progress. But Nashville’s mayor, Megan Barry, ended up resigning in scandal, and “the political climate was not real stable” for a big event, Mattioli said.

Much like the ever-present talk about NASCAR returning to the Fairgrounds, the possibility of an IndyCar race in Nashville was out there for so long that it ceased appearing all that possible anymore.

And then, it happened.

Sunday’s race materialized largely through the persistence of Music City Grand Prix CEO Matt Crews, who’d worked previously with Mattioli, and his team.

“I came up with the idea, OK, but they got it done,” Mattioli said. “So they deserve the credit. I’m just thrilled.”

Now 68, Mattioli is living in suburban Dallas, working as a consultant. He sure wasn’t going to miss Nashville’s first IndyCar race and road race, though: “It’s like I’m going to my daughter’s wedding but somebody else is paying for it.”

Was a fun weekend for a wedding party.

In Nashville, they usually are.

Regular-season title ‘a battle all the way to the end’

The battle for the regular-season championship in the NASCAR Cup Series between Denny Hamlin and Kyle Larson is coming down to the wire.

Following Larson’s fifth win of the season Sunday afternoon on the road course at Watkins Glen in New York, he moved into a tie with Hamlin for the overall points lead. Hamlin has led the standings since the second race of the season and has been one of the most consistent drivers in the series despite not having won a race.

Hamlin was fifth in the Go Bowling at The Glen, his fourth top-10 finish in five road course races this season. He and Larson lead the series with 15 top-10 finishes.

“It’s going to be a battle all the way to the end, I think,” Hamlin said. “Really proud of our effort today. We passed, had to be the most cars. We were really, really fast all day. Proud of this whole FedEx Express team. We’ve come a long way on the road courses.

“I thought we had equal pace with the 5 (Larson), especially on the long run. Obviously, we made an extra stop there

for whatever reason. It’s an encouraging day when we can be as competitive as what we were.”

Three races remain in the regular season. The driver who wins the regular-season championship will be awarded 15 playoff points, which likely sounds better than 10 points for being second in the standings for Hamlin.

While Larson and Hendrick Motorsports might be considered the championship favorite with his bucket of wins and playoff points, Hamlin and Joe Gibbs Racing have put in a solid season. The two are primed to race each other hard down this final stretch.

Larson is the new series leader – taking the spot from Hamlin after Watkins Glen – with 265 stage points. Hamlin has 261. But Larson is clearly ahead of Hamlin and the rest of the competition regarding race wins (five to Hamlin’s zero) and stage wins (12 to Hamlin’s five).

Larson also expects the points to be decided after the last lap in the regular-season finale at Daytona International Speedway.

“(Hamlin) is so good at Daytona, too, so it would be nice to get a couple good weeks and get that point lead because I know he’s going to go there, and any-

thing can happen at Daytona,” said Larson. “But I know he’s going to go there, and he’s going to get stage points, and he’s going to challenge for the win. I know he’s looking at me as the same.

“If he could go into Daytona being even or ahead, he’s going to feel like he’s

got the advantage. I’d like to have a good couple weeks before we get there and give us a little bit of wiggle room.”

The regular-season championship has not been a source of entertainment in recent seasons. Kevin Harvick clinched it midway through the second-to-last race of the regular season last year. Kyle Busch claimed the honor in both 2018 and ’19, and in ’18 did so midway through the final race of the regular season.

“I want everybody to race me hard,” Larson said of battling Hamlin. “He ran me really hard at Road America and put me in a couple bad spots to where I almost ended up in the grass, or if I didn’t lift, I was going to send him spinning. So, then I knew points was on his mind, and trying to hold me back is definitely on his mind.

“Yeah, it’s fun racing him, and I look forward to the next few weeks and really even into the playoffs. There’s still a lot of racing left, and yeah, it’s going to be fun. I’m glad there’s a fun little regular-season point battle, and I feel like, in years past, it’s kind of been a blowout come the last race of the points. But yeah, to be tied with three races left is pretty cool.”
