Schottenheimer one of 8 with 200 wins

Marty Schottenheimer, the longtime NFL head coach who came agonizingly close to reaching the Super Bowl several times only to fall short, has died at 77.

Schottenheimer died Monday in hospice care in Charlotte, North Carolina. His family shared the news through Bob Moore, a former Chiefs publicist, The Associated Press reported.

Schottenheimer served as head coach in Cleveland, Kansas City, Washington and San Diego from 1984 to 2006, compiling a regular-season record of 200-126-1 (.613) and reaching the post-season 13 times. He is one of eight head coaches in NFL history to reach the 200-win mark.

Schottenheimer was known as a "player's coach," forming deep bonds with those who shared a locker room with him. He was famous for his motivational speeches and phrases, among them: "There's a gleam, men! There's a gleam. Let's get the gleam."

His teams were a model of consistency. Only twice in 21 seasons did they post a losing record.

Despite all his successes — which included eight division titles, 13 playoff berths and one coach of the year award — Schottenheimer will be remembered most for the often soul-crushing losses his teams suffered in the playoffs.

Martin Edward Schottenheimer was born Sept. 23, 1943, in Canonsburg, Pennsylvania. He played linebacker at the University of Pittsburgh and was selected in both the NFL and AFL drafts in 1965. He signed with the Bills, where he was named to the AFL All-Star team in his first season. Schottenheimer played five more seasons, three with the Bills and two with the Boston Patriots, before his playing career came to an end.

He got his first coaching job at 31 with the Portland Storm of the upstart World Football League. He broke into the NFL

ranks coaching linebackers for the Giants, ascending to the role of defensive coordinator in 1977 at 34.

After two seasons with the Lions, Schottenheimer joined the Browns as defensive coordinator. Midway through the 1984 season, with the team 1-7 under Sam Rutigliano, Schottenheimer took over as head coach and led the Browns to a 4-4 mark to finish the season.

Two years later, he had the Browns in the playoffs, winning the AFC Central Division with a 12-4 record. But in the AFC championship game in Cleveland, Broncos quarterback John Elway led his team 98 yards for the tying touchdown in the final minute of regulation in what would come to be known as "The Drive." The Broncos kicked a field goal in overtime to advance to the Super Bowl.

In 1987, the Browns and Broncos repeated as division champions and met again in Denver in the AFC title game. This time the Broncos jumped out to a 21-3 halftime lead. Trailing 38-31 and inside the Denver 10 with just over a minute left in the game, Cleveland running back Earnest Byner lost control of the ball just before he was about to cross the goal line and likely force another overtime. "The Fumble" was recovered by the Broncos to seal the game.

Schottenheimer left the Browns in 1989, taking over as head coach of the Chiefs. After missing the playoffs in his first year, he led the Chiefs to the post-

season each of the next six seasons.

"Marty will rightfully be remembered as one of the greatest coaches in NFL history, but his legacy extends far beyond his winning percentage. He was a passionate leader who cared deeply for his players and coaches, and his influence on the game can still be seen today on a number of coaching staffs around the league," Chiefs CEO Lamar Hunt said in a statement.

Leaving Kansas City after the 1998 season, Schottenheimer worked as an analyst for ESPN for two years before returning to the sideline in Washington. His lone season there produced an 8-8 record. The final stop in his NFL journey came in San Diego, where he went 47-33 with two playoff appearances.

Schottenheimer's influence around the NFL is still being felt today. Sixteen of his former assistants — including Bruce Arians, Bill Cowher and Tony Dungy — have gone on to become NFL head coaches.

In 2011, Schottenheimer was diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease.

"The Cleveland Browns are saddened to learn of the passing of Marty Schottenheimer," the team relayed in a statement. "As a head coach, he led the organization to four playoff appearances and three divisional titles, but it was his tough, hard-nosed, never give up the fight attitude the team embodied that endeared him to Browns fans."

Postseason results reshuffle final top 14

NFL power rankings, final 2020 season edition (previous rank in parentheses):

1. Buccaneers (6): The newly minted champions became the first team to score at least 30 points four times in one postseason, vanquishing three former Super Bowl MVPs (Drew Brees, Aaron Rodgers, Patrick Mahomes) along the way. Next up ... depending on how the 2021 league schedule falls? QB Tom Brady and, presumably, TE Rob Gronkowski getting a shot at New England and old friend Bill Belichick.

2. Packers (2): They seem re-committed to Rodgers, now a three-time league MVP ... but what will GM Brian Gutekunst do to help his QB, who could lose RB Aaron Jones to free agency?

3. Chiefs (1): With a little luck, their depleted offensive line could be restored — perhaps even improved — to its previous Super Bowl 54 level. For Mahomes' sake, it needs to be.

4. Bills (3): Big steps in 2020, winning the AFC East for the first time in a quarter century and reaching the conference title game. Could a Super Bowl breakthrough be around the corner?

5. Rams (13): Since upsetting the Seahawks to reach the divisional round, Los Angeles added QB Matthew Stafford and subtracted a ton of draft capital ... but also Jared Goff's ungodly contract. This team should be legitimate Super Bowl contenders.

6. Ravens (5): Next orders of business? Extending QB Lamar Jackson's contract and getting him a No. 1 receiver.

7. Browns (9): Finally headed in a

productive direction, they'll have to ask themselves whether they're a better team with or without WR Odell Beckham Jr. moving forward.

8. Seahawks (7): What happened to the offense? "Teams just started to figure us out," according to WR DK Metcalf. Be interesting to see what QB Russell Wilson and Co. figure out in 2021 with some new cooks in the kitchen.

9. Titans (10): A year ago, we wondered what RB Derrick Henry would do for an encore. Asking that anew, should we wonder if he'll break Eric Dickerson's single-season rushing record?

10. Saints (4): The Brees era apparently comes to a close with another aborted playoff run. New Orleans' future may hold Jameis Winston at quarterback and a 2021 draft potentially stripped of valuable picks if the team's latest COVID-19 violations are especially egregious.

11. Steelers (8): They need to figure out how the future looks with QB Ben Roethlisberger and maybe without him ... which might mean turning to Dwayne Haskins.

12. Dolphins (12): They have two offensive coordinators, two first-round picks, two really good corners ... but need to find out if they have one really good QB.

13. Cardinals (14): If you're into interpreting retweets, sure seems like QB Kyler Murray would like Arizona to start reinvesting in the trenches.

14. Colts (11): Appropriate that a team in Indianapolis would have a beautifully crafted race car ... but no idea who's going to drive it.

15. Washington (15): Given they played the champion Bucs as tough as

anyone in the playoffs — while winging it at QB — every reason to be optimistic heading into Year 2 under Ron Rivera.

16. Patriots (17): Sounds like 2020 opt-outs Don'ta Hightower, Patrick Chung, Brandon Bolden and Marcus Cannon are opting back in.

17. Chargers (18): It's been an electric rise for new head coach Brandon Staley, though he'll have to be careful not to short-circuit rookie of the year Justin Herbert's development after his 2020 coaching support group was stripped away.

18. Cowboys (23): Want a little advice, Jerry? Make QB Dak Prescott's deserved contract extension the first item on the offseason checklist this year instead of the last.

19. 49ers (24): They'll be welcoming a lot of talented players back from injury ... but not departed DC Robert Saleh and perhaps not QB Jimmy Garoppolo.

20. Bears (16): After a valiant charge to the postseason, they're back to Square One times two — still looking for an answer at quarterback while hoping for a smooth break-in for rookie DC Sean Desha.

21. Falcons (19): New GM Terry Fontenot and coach Arthur Smith are in a peculiar predicament with this aging team, perhaps wishing they could reset like Detroit has.

22. Vikings (21): Getting Danielle Hunter (neck) and Michael Pierce (opt-out) back on the D-line should immediately begin solving a lot of problems.

23. Raiders (20): Seems like the annual Derek Carr rumors are off to an early start ... while unclear how many other QBs could more effectively mask a defense clipped for 30 points per week.

25. Giants (22): DL Leonard Williams was probably their best player in 2020, but can New York afford to franchise him again given how much the offense needs?

26. Panthers (26): Plenty of work for Matt Rhule and Co. to do, but sure seems like they're already keen on a quarterback switch.

27. Bengals (27): QB Joe Burrow's recovery from a torn ACL appears on track. Now Cincinnati needs to get the rebuild of the O-line on track.

28. Eagles (28): Tanking in Week 17, angering players, belatedly firing the coach, inviting a quarterback controversy. It's already been a tremendous 2021.

29. Jaguars (32): Rookie NFL coach Urban Meyer may be the far bigger question mark in 2021 than presumed rookie QB Trevor Lawrence. Wouldn't be surprising if this team gets a wild card ... but would be equally unsurprising if it remains a train wreck.

30. Jets (31): Is any team embarking on a more fascinating offseason? If QB Sam Darnold is fetching first-round offers, can GM Joe Douglas really say no?

31. Lions (30): Welp, apparently new coach Dan Campbell will be focusing on detached kneecaps for now since everything else "starts two years out, and it doesn't start right now."

32. Texans (29): Maybe the most disastrous start to an offseason any team has had since the time that one club traded All-Pro WR DeAndre Hopkins for a few kicking tees.
