i. <u>Contract holder reference</u>. If the contract holder undergoes a merger, acquisition, or partial assignment, in which case they still maintain the contract, then all transactions made under the existing contract number (including purchase orders) must reference the name of the awarded contract holder. The exception to this requirement is if the contract holder no longer holds the contract or if the company has been acquired by another company and undergone a name change. Reference is made to the following agreements:

• Contract numbers: R191815, R190503, R151103, R190202

(such agreements, together with all amendments, exhibits, schedules, appendices, statements of work, purchase orders, work orders thereto or any other agreements required under or related to such agreements heretofore entered, the "Agreements").

On July [ ], 2020, School Specialty, Inc. and certain of its subsidiaries (collectively, "School Specialty") entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement with SSI Acquisition, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (the "Buyer"), and an affiliate of the Buyer (the "Canadian Buyer"), pursuant to which School Specialty agreed to sell substantially all of its assets to the Buyer and the equity interests in its Canadian subsidiaries to the Canadian Buyer, on the terms and subject to the conditions set forth in the Asset Purchase Agreement (the "Transaction"). As part of the Transaction, School Specialty has agreed to assign to the Buyer all of its rights and obligations under the Agreements. The closing of the Transaction is subject to customary closing conditions and is expected to occur in the third quarter of 2020.

Substantially all of the management and employees of SSI are expected to transfer to the Buyer pursuant to the Transaction. As a result, the Transaction will have little impact on the day-to-day interactions under the Agreements. Nonetheless, the terms of the Agreements require your consent to an assignment to a third-party.
