'Glee' actor Mark Salling found dead

He was to be sentenced on child porn charges

Mark Salling, the former *Glee* star who pleaded guilty to possessing child pornography and was scheduled to be sentenced in March, was found dead Tuesday, an apparent suicide. He



confirmed his death to USA TODAY.

"I can confirm that Mark Salling passed away early this morning," Proctor said in an emailed statement to USA TODAY. "Mark was a gentle and loving person, a person of great creativity, who was doing his best to atone for some serious mistakes and errors of judgment. He is survived by his mother and father, and his brother."

Salling was scheduled to be sentenced in early March under a plea

Crimes Against Children Task Force served a search warrant on his home in the foothills of the San Gabriel Mountains.

In May 2016, he was charged with receiving and possessing child pornography, the Justice Department in Los Angeles announced.
