Good afternoon,

In compliance with the terms and conditions of our contract, Jasper Seating Company, Inc. (dba JSI) is requesting modification to our contract to impose a 9% temporary surcharge. This is an initiative for our company to offset our increased costs for a short period of time allowing us to thoroughly evaluate inclines in the economy and allow a period of economic stabilization before going to print with a new price list. Our plan is to replace this surcharge with a new, updated price list Mid-year (June/July 2022). The 9% surcharge will remain in effect until this new price list will be accepted on contract.

Unprecedented changes in our industry have created a shortage of materials for manufacturers. Consequently, we are seeing a rise in cost of materials. These sudden, drastic shifts in the economy have also increased fuel for transportation and increased labor costs. While our company is prepared to absorb part of these increased prices, we are asking all of our customers to share a small portion of the expense.

Attached you will find our letter that went out commercially announcing the surcharge to take effect Feb 28, 2022.

As I am sure you are already painfully aware, we are continuing to be hit with unprecedented inflation. Several of our largest commodity categories have spiked 40%, and some as high as 75%. Wage inflation is also a significant factor that is weighing into our pricing. I wanted to take this time to let you know that we are planning another surcharge, then later this summer we plan to replace the surcharge with an updated price list. By that time, we are hopeful that material costs begin to level out, and the new published price list will integrate costs at that time.

Effective for orders placed on and after February 28, 2022, we will be adding an 9% surcharge to the order total, which will be reflected as a line item on your acknowledgment and invoice. This approach will follow the exact same process that we used for the surcharge that we applied last year. We apologize for any inconvenience administering this surcharge may cause you and we want to assure you that we continue to do all we can to offset cost increases.

Thanks in advance for your understanding and we look forward to the time when inflation and supply chain volatility normalizes.
