Starting in 2025, public schools in the state of California will be required to offer transitional kindergarten for all 4 year olds, and the program is already rolling out for the 2022-2023 school year.

## What does that mean for your school and its playground?

Your kindergarten playground is likely designed for children ages 5-12. However, Consumer Products Safety Commission (CPSC) establishes guidelines necessary for children aged 2-5. To remain compliant, you will need to update your playground to ensure that the equipment is suitable and safe for ages 4+.

## GET GRANT MONEY FOR UPDATING YOUR SCHOOL'S PLAYGROUND

There are several grants available for California school districts that can be used for costs associated with expanding TK enrollment, including retrofitting or building new facilities:

- Full-Day Kindergarten Facilities Grant Program: Two funding rounds are available April 1, 2022 – April 30, 2022, and April 1, 2023 – April 30, 2023.
- California Pre-Kindergarten Planning and Implementation Grant: Funds will be available until June 30, 2024.
