American Korda having a 'super' time

WIMBLEDON, England — Sebastian Korda is having a, um, "super" time at Wimbledon so far.

First and foremost, the 20-year-old American — part of a through-and-through sports family — won his debut at the grass-court Grand Slam tournament, eliminating No. 15 seed Alex de Minaur 6-3, 6-4, 6-7 (5-7), 7-6 (7-5) after nearly 3½ hours on Tuesday with some strong serving and an attacking style.

One of Korda's older sisters, Nelly Korda, won her first major title at the Women's PGA Championship last week to earn the No. 1 ranking in women's golf. The other, Jessica, is No. 13.

Their parents, Regina and Petr, were pro tennis players: mom was ranked in the top 30; dad won the 1998 Australian Open and was the runner-up at the 1992 French Open.

"It's super special having my dad here. We don't travel that often together, but whenever we do, it's really special," the younger Korda said. "And especially here at Wimbledon, it's super cool."

Notice a pattern?

Korda, who turns 21 next week and is based in Bradenton, Florida, finds participating in his first Wimbledon "super exciting."

His father, who was at Court 17 to watch his son beat a player coming off a grass-court title last week, was "super happy" — although "he also sees the mistakes that I did during the match and he lets me know right away."

It's "super cool" that his siblings are going to compete at the Tokyo Olympics — although Korda said he hasn't made a decision yet.

Sebastian and his father got "super emotional" and were "super happy" while watching Nelly win her women's major the other day, which was "super cool."

professional era record of 22 and move within one of Margaret Court's all-era mark of 24.

"All the best for her," said Sasnovich, who reached the fourth round at Wimbledon in 2018 for her best Grand Slam result.

Williams' departure makes a wide-open women's draw even more so. As it was, defending champion Simona Halep and four-time major champ Naomi Osaka withdrew before the tournament started.

And so, even as her 40th birthday approaches in September, Williams was among the top contenders. With her best-in-the-game serve and stinging ground strokes, she had made it to the past four finals when she entered Wimbledon — winning in 2015 and 2016, missing the tournament while pregnant in 2017, then finishing as the runner-up in 2018 and 2019 (it was canceled last year because of the pandemic).

Williams was hardly the first player to find it difficult to deal with the slick grass over the first two days of main-draw play.

In the match that preceded hers in the main stadium, eight-time Wimbledon champion Federer advanced when his opponent, Adrian Mannarino, hurt his right leg late in the fourth set when he tumbled near the same spot Williams did.

Federer was trailing two sets to one but was ahead 4-2 in the fourth when Mannarino fell. He tried to continue but dropped eight of nine points when they resumed and called it quits.

"Obviously," Federer acknowledged, "he was the better player."

Novak Djokovic fell twice in the first set of his first-round victory Monday at Centre Court, too.

"I do feel it feels a tad more slippery, maybe, under the roof. I don't know if it's just a gut feeling. You do have to move very, very carefully out there. If you push too hard in the wrong mo-

ments, you do go down," Federer said. "I do feel it's drier during the day. With the wind and all that stuff, it takes the moist out of the grass."

"But this is obviously terrible."

It was, by far, the most significant development Tuesday, when the winners included Williams' older sister, 41-year-old Venus, 17-year-old Coco Gauff, reigning French Open champion Barbora Krejickova and No. 1 seed Ash Barty in the women's bracket, and No. 2 Daniil Medvedev, No. 4 Alexander Zverev and No. 10 Denis Shapovalov in the men's.

Sebastian Korda — a 20-year-old American whose father, Petr, won the 1998 Australian Open and whose sisters, No. 1-ranked Nelly and No. 13 Jessica, are on the LPGA tour — made a successful Wimbledon debut, eliminating No. 15 seed Alex de Minaur 6-3, 6-4, 6-7 (5-7), 7-6 (7-5).

Venus Williams accumulated 10 aces by smacking serves at up to 114 mph — not quite like the old days, but not too shabby, either. She drove forehands to corners. She made her way to the net for crisp volleys.

And when it was all over, she celebrated her first Wimbledon match win

since 2018 by raising her arms and yelling "Come on!" before reprising her familiar smile-and-twirl wave at No. 3 Court.

A five-time singles champion at the All England Club who is making her 23rd appearance here, the elder Williams sister began her record-extending 90th Grand Slam tournament with her 90th career victory at Wimbledon, beating Mihaela Buzarnescu of Romania 7-5, 4-6, 6-3.

Venus Williams is a former No. 1-ranked player who came into this week ranked 11th and having lost in the first or second round at the past eight majors. That included a first-round exit in 2019 at the All England Club against a then-15-year-old Gauff.

"You can't win them all. Life is about how you handle challenges. Each point is a challenge on the court. No one gives you anything," said Venus Williams, who was diagnosed a decade ago with Sjogren's syndrome, an autoimmune disease that can cause fatigue and joint pain.

"I like to think I handle my challenges well."

magnified so much when he doesn't play well or he has a bad game," Lue said. "A lot of people play bad. I'm just happy he came back and played a great game."

George sure did.

George became the first player in NBA history to have at least 40 points on at least 75% shooting, 13 rebounds and six assists in a playoff game, according to Elias Sports Bureau. He cemented himself in the Clippers' record books as the fourth player in franchise history to have a 40-point postseason performance. And George is only 12 days removed from a 37-point performance against the Jazz in Game 5 of the Western Conference semifinals that was two points shy of his previous playoff career high.

Yet George still has fielded skepticism and criticism for his play ever since his struggles in last year's playoff run.

The scrutiny heightened again following the Clippers' Game 4 loss to Phoenix. Then, George shot only 5 of 20 from the field and 1 of 9 from 3-point range. He also missed a crucial free throw while the Clippers trailed 81-78 with 6.3 seconds remaining.

The telecast caught Clippers owner Steve Ballmer shaking his head and showing a disappointed look after George's miss. In Game 2, George also missed two free throws before the Suns won the game with Deandre Ayton's slam of an inbound lob.

"I don't know where this trolling (ex-

pletive) from where the internet controls the narrative about these players," Clippers center DeMarcus Cousins said. "It's becoming foolish, man. That's one of the most special players ever to lace his shoes. Give this dude his flowers, man. I don't understand the slander. It's becoming quite silly now. Respect these players, man. Respect these greats."

Cousins might be exaggerating.

George has received criticism because he underperformed in the NBA bubble in 2020. His free throw struggles in Games 2 and 4 played a factor in the Clippers' losses. Still, George has observed "it's the honest truth" and "it's a fact" that he has fielded more scrutiny for his poor play than others.

"I can't worry about that," George said. "It comes with the job, I guess. But it is what it is. I still try to go and dominate, whether I'm shooting the ball well or not shooting the ball well. I still try to dominate, just the whole game in general."

So George did.

Once again, George helped the Clippers in a high-stakes playoff game. Once again, George helped the Clippers absorb Kawhi Leonard's absence while nursing an injured right knee for the seventh consecutive game. And once again, George helped the Clippers adjust to a new ailment that include center Ivica Zubac becoming sidelined with a right knee injury.

The Clippers also credited Reggie Jackson (23 points), Marcus Morris Sr. (22) and Cousins (15) to ensure promising leads early in the first quarter (18-5 with 7:28 left), at halftime (59-52), after the third quarter (91-78) and through the final buzzer.

But most of the attention centered on George, considering his stature and the attention the Suns have given him.

"That's what great players do," Lue said. "You always bounce back. If you have a rough game, you always play well."

In George's case, he has shown remarkable resiliency for two reasons.

One, he has shrugged off sluggish performances and showed a strong ability to quickly forget about it. Though some fans might mistake George's reaction to apathy, he has shown remarkable composure with thinking tactically instead of emotionally.

Two, George has devoted a significant amount of time toward maximizing his health to ensure handling a heavy workload. Normally, George has arrived to postgame interviews about 90 minutes after the game so he can receive treatment and sit in both a cold and hot tub. George talked about 15 minutes after Game 5 ended. But he planned on following the same routine afterward "to making sure my body is as close to 100 as possible going into next game."

No wonder George considered his health playing a "big factor" into why he played better in Game 5 than in Game 4. "Tonight, my legs were under me," George said. "I felt strong physically."

That has not always been the case. George suffered a gruesome right leg injury with Team USA that caused him to miss the 2014 FIBA World Championships and all but the final eight games of the 2014-15 NBA season with the Pacers. Two summers ago, George had offseason surgery on both of his shoulders, causing him to miss 24 games in his first season with the Clippers last year.

"I definitely lost some things even with the shoulder surgeries," George said. "It's part of this game. You got to take it. You got to roll with it. Be able to adapt and just keep it moving. It is tough going through these injuries, rehabbing and finding a way to be yourself again. The good thing about it is you learn on the fly and how to adapt."

Hence, George said he felt more comfortable "letting the game come to me" instead of trying to dominate the game. So despite a poor first-quarter start (three points on 1 of 3 shooting, two turnovers), George made up for it in the second quarter (eight points on 4 of 5 shooting), the third quarter (20 points on 7 of 8 shooting) and the fourth quarter (10 points on 3 of 4 shooting).

"I'm happy he has this opportunity to be able to lead a team," Morris said. "We want Kawhi. We all love Kawhi. But I'm happy for Paul as a player where he's able to lead a team and show everybody what he's got because there's always a lot of chatter on how he plays and the things he does. But nobody really watches the day-to-day work he puts in, the kind of teammate he is and kind of player he is."

The Clippers do, though. So when George helped the Clippers salvage their postseason once again, the Clippers embraced him afterward.

"We don't have to pump him up. We know what Paul brings every night," Cousins said. "We don't get caught up in these silly narratives that are being pushed by the internet."

"We know what Paul brings every night. He's going to play on both ends of the floor. He's going to make the right play. He's unguardable."
