**2. Saints (9-2):** NFC South leader. They were fortunate to squeak past Panthers on Sunday – and even more so when Green Bay's loss moved them back into position for a bye. But sometimes it's better to be lucky than good. Saints won't get a free meal on Thanksgiving night in Atlanta, though their 26-9 loss to Falcons in Week 10 should serve as ample motivation – especially since revenge win would officially secure New Orleans' playoff ticket.

**3. Packers (8-3):** NFC North leader. Time for serious self-scouting after setback at San Francisco knocked them

from No. 2 slot. But Pack currently have just one more game remaining against opponent with winning record (at Minnesota in Week 16).

**4. Cowboys (6-5):** NFC East leader. As discouraging as their loss at New England was, battered Eagles (5-6) appear to be in far more dire position.

**5. Seahawks (9-2):** Wild card No. 1. They need misstep from 49ers to move up but can't lose focus themselves with freshened Vikings on way to Seattle for Monday night meeting to end Week 13.

**6. Vikings (8-3):** Wild card No. 2. Coming out of bye, they have tougher path to NFC North crown than Green Bay. But Vikes are now two games clear of closest pursuer for conference's final berth after Ravens dealt Rams (6-5) potentially mortal blow.

## AFC

**1. Patriots (10-1):** AFC East leader. Beat Cowboys in rain as they continue to try to extend their reign. But scant margin for error with division-leading Texans and Chiefs next up on docket. Pats punch 11th consecutive postseason card this weekend by winning coupled

with loss by either Steelers or Raiders.

**2. Ravens (9-2):** AFC North leader. After ravaging Rams, case bolstered they're league's top team. Pats one mistake from ceding top seed to Baltimore.

**3. Texans (7-4):** AFC South leader. Recovered from their beatdown at Baltimore to knock off Colts last Thursday and claim first place in division outright. Week 6 win at Kansas City moved Texans from sixth spot all the way to third. But beware, Texans, as you emerge from mini-bye: Patriots are coming to town.

**4. Chiefs (7-4):** AFC West leader. Coming out of off week, they'll host reeling Raiders (6-5) in Week 13.

**5. Bills (8-3):** Wild card No. 1. Dispatched Denver with ease but now head into short week that culminates with Thanksgiving date at Dallas.

**6. Steelers (6-5):** Wild card No. 2. This spot continues to be hot potato – Colts and Oakland, both also 6-5, have also held it in recent days – but Pittsburgh has reclaimed it ... for now. Steelers host Browns (5-6), who are playing much better than they are, in Week 13. Titans (6-5) also squarely in mix and can help own tiebreaking scenarios by winning at Indianapolis.

When coaches, players, fans and broadcasters can't tell you what constitutes PI, or are so often mystified by the rulings after instant replay, it underscores a major confidence issue with respect to the integrity of the games.

"It's a significant crisis brought on by this pass interference rule," Mike Pereira, the rules analyst for Fox Sports, told USA TODAY Sports. "It set up Al Riveron for failure. They're trying to use a different standard for replays versus what is actually the standard on the field. What is gray is even more gray."

Controversy over pass interference follows issues in recent years that include helmet-to-helmet infractions and the catch rule. The NFL was aggressive in trying to legislate the prevention of another debacle like the NFC title game case, but the unintended consequences are blowing up in its face.

Riveron, maintaining that the PI calls won't be reversed unless they are "clear and obvious," has reversed only a small percentage (19.4%) of the reviews. Prior to Monday night's game, there were 15 reversals of 77 pass interference reviews. Now, some coaches often refuse to challenge plays they otherwise might.

As Payton put it, "Throw a (challenge) flag at your own peril."

Beyond that, the lack of consistency with the rulings after the reviews intensifies the controversy. Your "clear and obvious" isn't always my "clear and obvious." Pereira, who served as the

league's director of officiating before joining Fox in 2010, said that some PI infractions have been ignored merely because they didn't rise to the level of what happened in the NFC title game.

Pereira, incidentally, thought Humphrey should have been flagged for the end-zone mugging of Hopkins. And he agrees with Payton that a defensive pass interference issued on review against Saints safety Chauncey Gardner-Johnson on Sunday didn't meet the "clear and obvious" standard.

Yet Pereira stops short of blaming Riveron for all of the officiating woes.

"I feel badly for Al," Pereira said. "This (pass interference rule) has made his job tougher than my job ever was. And it's tougher than it ever was for Dean Blandino, Carl Johnson, Jerry Seeman or Art McNally."

In other words, no one has been in that hot-seat job with as much pressure as Riveron. This PI tweak was the solution NFL owners came up with last spring after weeks of haggling and brainstorming with coaches and the competition committee. It's not working, raising more credibility questions and setting the stage for the potential of more controversial drama down the stretch on the road to Super Bowl LIV.

Perfection is unreasonable, but Riveron hasn't helped himself with so many iffy rulings.

That's why Payton wants a panel for reviews. The coach mentioned the U.S. Supreme Court structure in his argument for multiple sets of eyes for reviews. He alludes to tapping input from his coaching staff while devising game plans.

"I'd be stir-crazy if it was just me," Payton said.

Pereira scoffs at Payton's suggestion. "Numbers only add to confusion," Pereira said.

As it stands now, Riveron likely can consult with others, such as replay director Russell Yurk, who handles the administration of replay reviews, before issuing his final rulings. Pereira is wary of a panel and cited issues with MLB's replay system, with multiple umpires weighing in.

"Too many opinions can create other problems," Pereira said. "What if there were five guys and two say one thing and three have the opposite view?"

Bottom line: The NFL needs another officiating fix that must be driven by incorporating common sense for the structure of the specific role for Riveron and others.

It's such a mess now that Pereira maintains that if NFL commissioner Roger Goodell called offering a huge financial package for him to return to his former job – "And he wouldn't," Pereira added – he would decline.

"No way would I want to do it."

The old job allowed for the director of officiating to handle development, quality control and to be a buffer between the league and teams – an area representing another knock on Riveron. Yet for Riveron, those duties are seemingly complicated by the additional responsibility as arbiter for all reviews.

"He's a good man," Pereira said, "that's been put in an impossible situation."

A situation that has Riveron constantly feeling the fire.
