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# Harvick, Childers find fast success

Kevin Harvick and Rodney Childers have won three races since NASCAR resumed its Cup Series season, and there might be a simple answer why.

To start, Childers believes the No. 4 Stewart-Haas Racing team has "the best group" in the garage – from those in the shop down to the pit crew and those on the road. And people, as Childers doesn't have to explain, are an essential part of any successful race team.

Second, the format NASCAR has adapted under COVID-19 restrictions fits the group Childers has put together. Besides the three wins, Harvick has seven top-10 finishes in the last 10 races and continues to lead the point standings.

"I will say that I feel like, for the 4

team, it's an advantage to unload and not have practice and those things," said Childers. "(The) history of our team has been unloading good and doing a great job at the racetrack (with) details and all that stuff. So I think some of this since we have (gone) back to racing has been in our hands and our wheelhouse a little bit. Obviously, with being able to win three of them and coming close to even more, that part shows. It's been a great deal for us so far, and hopefully we can keep it up."

Only the Coca-Cola 600 at Charlotte has had a qualifying session. Other than that, NASCAR has been running one-day shows with drivers showing up and racing.

Pocono, however, was hosting two Cup races this weekend. After 325 miles Saturday, teams worked on their cars to turn them around for 350 miles Sunday

afternoon. Harvick said after taking the checkered flag, he thought his team could make the No. 4 Ford Mustang a little better.

"I think the experience of our team plays a huge role," said Harvick. "I think the experience of our organization plays a bigger role. We have a boss who has been through a lot of different situations that the company has had to navigate in order to move things around, change things, do a lot of things when Tony (Stewart) had his accidents. There were those type of situations where we had to put different drivers in the car. It was definitely not easy."

"I think when you look at a company that is able to navigate those types of times, this is a very similar situation with the same group of people. You listen to the things that are happening, the way the shop has to be organized and work, it's difficult. To be able to take this quality of cars to the racetrack is definitely a huge credit to everybody at Stewart-Haas Racing."

# New softball team spreads racial harmony

VIERA, Fla. – Wearing black socks, pants and jerseys with the words "THIS IS US" across their chests, a newly reorganized pro softball team delivered a message of unity off the field Saturday night and scored a major victory on it.

Five days after disenfranchising themselves from the Texas-based Scrap Yard Dawgs after a since-deleted general manager's tweet regarding the national anthem and aimed at President Donald Trump, the 18 players, plus coaches, were back on the field doing what they do best.

Team USA pitchers Keilani Ricketts and Cat Osterman – two of 11 Olympic players traveling with the team this summer – combined for seven strikeouts in the 3-1 victory against the USSSA Pride, the reigning two-time National Pro Fastpitch champions.

"Just because something may seem negative, we showed you can always turn it into a positive," said first base-

man Sam Fischer. "And not be afraid in doing so."

"This Is Us" began appearing on players' Twitter handles Thursday. The next day, the team released a black-and-white video, which was shown to fans in the fifth game at Saturday's game. "While we were playing our first game of the season, a tweet was sent out on behalf of the organization that was insensitive, offensive and ignorant to the movement going on in this country," Fischer says in the video. The players are emphasizing three points: "We are here to raise awareness. We are here to empower. We are here to unite."

The video had garnered more than 22,000 views as of Saturday morning. ESPN's Holly Rowe, a veteran sideline reporter during the NCAA softball post-season, chimed in on Twitter: "I hope some big corporation gets behind this team and supports them. It takes courage to walk out on your job for what you believe. Go Ladies!!! I am donating immediately!!!!"

The new team's mission statement

says it is "here to spark a necessary change in the softball community, gaining and sharing knowledge about racial injustice in our world."

Fischer said the capitalized names on the back of the players' jerseys are to acknowledge Black players, past and present, who have played and coached the game. "I wore Natasha Watley's name because when I came up I started out as a shortstop and just idolized the way she played," she said of the UCLA Olympian.

Last Monday, the Dawgs had lost 4-0 to the Pride in what was the first professional team sports competition in the U.S. following the coronavirus pandemic shutdown of most athletics in March. By the time the players gathered in the locker room, word got out that GM Connie May had put up a personal tweet on the team's official site. A confrontation between players and May lasted about an hour before Kiki Stokes, the only Black player on the roster, walked out.

"I felt alone, isolated, very confused," the Nebraska star told many of the estimated 250 fans who stayed after Satur-

day's game for a panel discussion. "I represented the organization for five years. A team I trusted. But I was let down and felt betrayed. But the people (teammates) in that room moved mountains for me."

Stokes said it took "just seconds" for the rest of the team to follow her out the door, leaving contracts behind and an uncertain future but not regrets.

Sam Show, known for her home run bat-flip at Oklahoma State, said she was worried if she'd done the right thing after walking out on her first pro contract. "I don't like crying in front of people but I did this week," she said. "I knew it was right. Showing the softball world what you believe in and finding your happiness (made it the correct decision)."

Stokes said she already is seeing positives: "I'm already seeing little black girls out there running around. When I was younger, I was told, 'You play a white sport.' I didn't feel that way. I've always felt like, just because I'm not white, I can still bring something back to the table."
