Minschew Jags' undisputed leader

Foles trade keeps young QB starter

Quarterback Gardner Minschew said they have plenty to prove this upcoming season because most preseason predictions have the Jacksonville Jaguars heading for their third consecutive losing season.

In his first Zoom call with reporters last Thursday, Gardner Minschew didn't wear his customary bandana.

But his mustache was thick, and so was his beard.

He did not flash his wit as frequently as he used to do last season, but he greeted a reporter by saying it's good to see you even though you don't have your camera on, but that's cool.

The regular season is four months away from starting, but already there's anticipation on how Minschew is going to perform. He is now the undisputed leader. He is the franchise quarterback who does not have to split the first-team reps with anyone.

The Jaguars traded Nick Foles to the Chicago Bears in March. And in April, they didn't select a quarterback high in the draft or acquire Cam Newton or Jameis Winston in free agency.

They stuck behind Minschew, who shined enough as a rookie to unseat Foles and go 6-6 as a starter in 2019. It provided Minschew Mania to a fan base in Jacksonville that's desperate to see more wins.

"It didn't change anything that I do," Minschew said about the Jaguars not acquiring a high-profile rookie quarterback in the draft or proven veteran in

working with his personal coach Ken Mastrole in Naples.

Though Minschew has returned home to Brandon, Miss., he has stuck to his workout routine because of their home gym. He has also been able to get in throws at his former high school and at a local park that he said just recently reopened.

After the season, Minschew gained about 10 pounds to get up to 230 but said he's now between 222 to 225.

"Really, I put an emphasis on what's the best weight for me to have as much arm strength as possible while maintaining as much speed," Minschew said. "So just figuring that out has been a fun process. I've had a lot of help."

Minschew has leaned on tight end Tyler Eifert and running back Chris Thompson to learn the intricacies of offensive coordinator's Jay Gruden's offense.

Eifert played for Gruden in 2013 with the Cincinnati Bengals. Thompson was with Gruden from 2014 through last season with the Washington Redskins.

Earlier this week, Gruden said it was his job to make sure his personality meshes with Minschew, who had the highest passer rating (91.2) among any of the seven rookie quarterbacks who earned starts last season.

Minschew's 21 passing touchdowns and his 3,271 yards were the most by a rookie in franchise history.

"He has shown a skill set where he can sit in a pocket, step up, make things happen outside the pocket," Gruden said.

"He's accurate, he's tough, and he's a great leader, so he's got the intangibles you want in a quarterback. Now he's got to get to know the team, get to know the offense a little bit so we can all gel together."

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Flacco 'embracing' role as QB mentor

At 35, Joe Flacco still believes he has the talent to be a starting quarterback in the NFL. And the former Super Bowl winner with the Baltimore Ravens is hopeful he'll get the chance to start again at some point in the future.

But Flacco knows that desire must be put on the back burner for now. The moment he signed with the Jets in May, his main job became to do whatever he can to support young quarterback Sam Darnold.

"I'm fully embracing it," Flacco said last week on a video conference with reporters. "It's where I am right now and I'm glad to be on a team playing football in some capacity. And I think it's going to be huge to get in there and know the guys and develop a relationship with the team and do anything I can to help the team get better and in that process, help Sam with whatever he needs help with."

Last year in Denver, Flacco took heat for not embracing a mentorship role with young quarterback Drew Lock — back then, Flacco said he didn't view

free agency.

"I had conversations with [general manager] Dave Caldwell. I told him to do what he thinks is best for the team. I believe I'm going to give us the best chance to win, no matter what. I just got to prove that every day. I'm excited about the opportunity to be able to prove that."

Still, the Las Vegas oddsmakers do not think the Jaguars will be any better than last season when they fared 6-10. BetOnline has the Jaguars tied with the Cincinnati Bengals and New York Giants for the worst odds to win the Super Bowl at 250-1.

According to the 2020 record projections of USA TODAY, the Jaguars are predicted to finish 3-13 and fourth in the AFC South.

As one of the youngest teams in league with 67 players on their 90-man roster with four years or fewer of experience, the Jaguars are also a consensus early favorite to land the No. 1 pick in the 2021 draft based on their projected record for this coming season.

"I think it should put a chip on everybody's shoulder on our team to be kind of counted out like that," Minschew said. "I think we do have a lot to prove that we're not what anybody says about us. I think we're going to set those expectations for ourselves and not worry about what anybody else has to say about us."

Because of COVID-19 precautions, the Jaguars' voluntary offseason program has been virtual only. Minschew, however, spent part of the offseason

that as a his job. But that was a different situation.

A year ago, Flacco signed a long-term deal to be the starter before the Broncos took Lock No. 42 overall in the draft. Flacco struggled, got injured and ended up being cut after playing only a year of a long-term contract. Lock, who played well replacing him, is set to be the starter moving forward.

"I obviously know that at this point, right now at this point in time I know what my role is, and I'm glad to do so," Flacco said. "It is what it is, and things were different last year."

Flacco said last year's experience — when he was unable to contribute after being injured — will help him embrace his new role.

"I know what it's like to not feel like being part of a team because you really can't have your hand in things," Flacco said. "And I think in the role I'm in now, you can definitely have a good, positive effect on the team."

"I obviously still believe that I'm a starting quarterback, and you never know what three years down the line is going to look like, so I still have that confidence and I still have the want, the

want to do that. But at this moment, that's not my role."

Flacco said the hardest part of this offseason was surgery on the herniated disc in his neck and "coming to grips with what this season was going to be."

Flacco had surgery in early April and isn't expected to be ready for the first week of the season. General manager Joe Douglas worked with Flacco in Baltimore -- he played a big role in scouting Flacco and the Ravens drafting him 18th overall in 2008.

Flacco grew up in South Jersey and has a home near Cherry Hill, where he

will be living near most of his family.

He said he hasn't spent a lot of time watching Darnold's game tape but talked to him last Thursday.

"My impression is that he's a young guy that has really good athleticism, can move in the pocket, can move out of the pocket, create things for himself, has the arm strength to do what he wants with the ball, both in the pocket and out of the pocket," Flacco said. "So I would say the biggest thing is just to get him to play as fast as possible, just after talking to him, so he can use all of those things in his toolbox."
