Tax rules loosened for charity giving

Congress raised donation limits amid pandemic



If you're inclined to support charities, 2020 could be a special year for that.

The usual nonprofit funding needs were worsened by the pandemic. Many charitable organizations have seen donations drop and revenue-generating events canceled while grappling with increased demand for their services.

A survey in late October from the Alliance of Arizona Nonprofits found that nearly two-thirds of charity organizations in the state expect to face net operating losses of 10% or greater, and some groups voiced concerns about their long-term viability.

Congress responded by loosening the tax rules a bit for people who make donations to assist nonprofit groups.

Use this year's special deduction

Taxpayers who itemize may deduct donations to charitable groups. This basic tax rule wasn't altered. What changed is a special donation deduction of up to \$300 for people who don't item-

This provision was created in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. There's speculation in tax circles that it might be continued in some form in future years. "It might not be a pure one and done," said Justin Smith, a certified financial planner with expertise in charitable donations at Savant Wealth Management in Phoenix.

Max out donations if you want

to qualified charities and seek to take an itemized deduction usually face restrictions. Normally, you may deduct donations of up to 60% of your adjusted gross income, with no tax benefit above that.

For 2020, Congress temporarily raised the limit to 100%, meaning you could effectively give away an amount equal to all of your adjusted gross income for the year and deduct it if you have the means and inclination to do so.

Donate from your IRA

A special donation rule applies for seniors with a charitable bent. Taxpayers aged 70½ and older who have Individual Retirement Accounts can donate up to \$100,000 annually to charities and count the gifts toward satisfying their required minimum distributions, or RMDs, for the year.

Why not just donate using non-IRA money? Because making a direct payment as a "qualified charitable distribution" may offer tax and other benefits. Even though RMDs were waived for 2020, you might want to pursue this option if you're of the right age, have an IRA and don't need the money for living expenses.

The amount donated as a qualified charitable distribution doesn't qualify as a direct tax deduction, as normally would be the case. It also doesn't get included as adjusted gross income. Direct, non-IRA donations, by contrast, lower taxable income but not adjusted gross income, noted Jeffrey Levine, a tax commentator for Kitces.com who heads Buckingham Wealth Partners.

Why does all that matter? If you have Medicare Part B or D coverage, you might face increased premium payments as your AGI rises. A higher AGI could subject you to the 3.8% surtax on net investment tax that hits high-income individuals. So to the extent that a qualified charitable distribution doesn't get included in AGI, you could save

For a qualified charitable distribution, there's no specific tax return box to check or form to fill out, Smith said. So be sure to include documentation such as a receipt from the charity showing that you donated money directly from your IRA in this manner.

Give away securities, not cash

During a speech sponsored by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants, Levine emphasized that it's often much wiser, from a tax-planning perspective, to donate assets other than cash - specifically stocks, mutual funds or other assets on which you have unrealized paper gains.

Not only could these types of gifts qualify you for a charitable deduction but you also wouldn't face capital gains tax on the profits, as you would if you sold them first, then donated the pro-

Just be aware that you would need to donate appreciated assets held in taxable accounts to receive these benefits. Those in IRAs, 401(k) plans and the like wouldn't qualify for the same capital gains avoidance.

Bunch up if you can

Because taxpayers often don't have all that much in charitable donations and other deductions each year, many advisers recommend a bunching strategy. In this approach, you would donate more than you normally would one year, then give less or nothing the next.

For example, if you typically give \$5,000 annually to charities but wouldn't have enough to itemize, consider doubling that one year to \$10,000. When combined with other routine deductions, you might have enough to itemize. For 2020, itemizing kicks in if you have deductions above \$12,400 for singles or \$24,800 for married couples. Below those levels, you would take the standard deduction instead.

Consider a charitable fund

Another option – especially if you're not sure where you want to donate – is to set up a donor advised fund, allowing you to make a large gift one year (and take the tax deduction then), while spreading your disbursements to charities over several years.

Many large brokerages, including Charles Schwab, Fidelity Investments and Vanguard, can set up donor advised funds, as can certain philanthropic groups such as the Arizona Community Foundation.

Make sure you include digital assets in your estate

There was a time when you didn't worry much about your email account, or the website you bought years ago, or your usernames and passwords for various financial and other accounts.

But now you do. Now you must make sure that your loved ones have access to your digital assets should you die.

"Digital assets are becoming more and more prominent parts of people's estates - they just can't be ignored anymore," says Karen Van Voorhis, a certified financial planner with Daniel J. Galli & Associates.

So how do make sure your digital assets don't die with you?

Here's what experts say:

Digital assets ino your estate plan

Almost everyone neglects to consider this, no matter their age, says Kashif Ahmed, president of American Private

"Make provisions in your will to authorize your designated executor to be able to retrieve your digital assets, and also to be able to shut down your digital accounts, especially social media such as Facebook.

Barbara O'Neill, the CEO of Money Talk, recommends completing a digital assets inventory worksheet and sharing it with trusted individuals such as your spouse and the executor of your estate.

A word of caution: Expect this task to take several hours to confirm usernames and passwords, says O'Neill.

And don't overlook any account, says Van Voorhis.

"Accounts with an actual monetary value like PayPal or Venmo are actually includable in your estate, and someone needs to know how to access them if something happens to you," she says.

Use password management

Leveraging a service like LastPass, Dashlane, or Password Boss provides a convenient means for inventorying all your online accounts and can also help you create more secure passwords, says

Make sure too, says Thomas Murphy, a certified financial planner with Murphy & Sylvest that someone else - your designated executor or financial power of attorney, knows how to access those

When available, Meinhart says the best option is to use service providers' own account tools.

Create a digital vault

Dana Menard, the founder and CEO of Twin Cities Wealth Strategies, gives all his financial planning clients their own "digital vault" in which they can store all of their important documents like their estate planning documents, mortgage paperwork, copies of personal identification, credit cards, pictures and even family recipes.

Van Voorhis recommends Everplans, a site meant to help people group all their important information in one place – including usernames and passwords. Users can assign a "deputy" who can also access all their information.

"It's great not only for digital assets but also for organizing medical, health, home, insurance, tax and other information," she says.
