## Texas HB-496

House Bill 496 has been passed by the Texas Legislature and mandates all schools to implement a Stop the Bleed program by January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020

The law requires bleeding control training for staff and students in all school districts as well as accessible bleeding control kits.

School districts are complying with the funded mandate by placing a bleeding control kit in EVERY classroom and common area for quick access during lockdowns.
