The Minnesota Public Agency (Sourcewell) issued RFP 040522 on February 15th, 2022, to establish a national cooperative contract for Food Products and Distribution (for other than School Food Authorities) with Related Supplies, Technology, and Services.

The solicitation included cooperative purchasing language in Sections I, subsection A. and subsection B:

A. SOURCEWELL

Sourcewell is a State of Minnesota local government unit and service cooperative created under the laws of the State of Minnesota (Minnesota Statutes Section 123A.21) that facilitates a competitive public solicitation and contract award process for the benefit of eligible participating entities across the United States. Sourcewell's solicitation process complies with State of Minnesota law and policies, and results in cooperative purchasing solutions from which Sourcewell's eligible Participating Entities procure equipment, products, and services.

Cooperative purchasing provides participating entities and suppliers increased administrative efficiencies and the power of combined purchasing volume that result in overall cost savings. At times, Sourcewell also partners with other purchasing cooperatives to combine the purchasing volume of their membership into a single solicitation and contract expanding the reach of contracted suppliers' potential pool of end users.

Sourcewell uses a website-based platform, the Sourcewell Procurement Portal, through which all proposals to this RFP must be submitted.

B. USE OF RESULTING CONTRACTS

In the United States, Sourcewell's contracts are available for use by:

- Federal and state government entities;
- Cities, towns, and counties/parishes;
- Education service cooperatives;
- K-12 and higher education entities;
- Tribal government entities;
- Some nonprofit entities; and
- Other public entities.

Participating Entities typically access contracted equipment, products, or services through a purchase order issued directly to the contracted supplier. A Participating Entity may request additional terms or conditions related to a purchase. Use of Sourcewell contracts is voluntary and Participating Entities retain the right to obtain similar equipment, products, or services from other sources.

To meet Participating Entities' needs, Sourcewell broadly publishes public notice of all solicitation opportunities, including this RFP. In the United States each state-level procurement department receives notice for possible re-posting.

On April 5th, 2021 proposals were received from the following offerors:

The proposals were evaluated by an evaluation committee. Using the evaluation criteria established in the RFP, the committee elected to enter into negotiations with US Foods, Inc. and proceeding with contract award upon successful completion of negotiations.

Term:

Initial term from June 9th, 2022, through June 3rd, 2026, with the option to renew for one (1) additional one-year periods through June 3rd, 2027.
