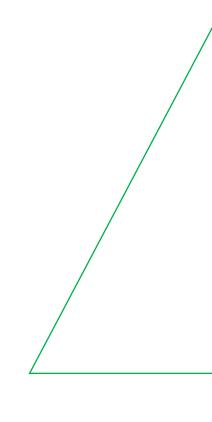

Cooperatives vary in size, but most are based on voluntary membership and democratic leadership. In order to use a cooperative contract, an organization usually must confirm their eligibility. While processing and assessing options, the purchasing agent or manager needs to access a Request for Proposal (RFP). The RFP information can be used to ensure that local requirements were met through the competitively-bid and legally-awarded contracts offered.
